- NOTICE -

- By law, certain property is exempt from execution. If any of your property listed above falls into any one of the following categories, you may be able to claim it as exempt and keep it.
1. In the case of judgment for money owed for health care services rendered or health care supplies provided to the person, one motor vehicle;
 2. Your interest, not to exceed \$1,000.00 in one motor vehicle
 3. Your interest, not to exceed \$200.00 in any particular item, in wearing apparel, beds, and bedding; and your interest, not to exceed \$300.00 in each item, in one cooking unit and one refrigerator or other food preservative unit;
 4. Your interest, not to exceed \$200.00 in any particular item, in household furnishings, household goods, appliances, books, animals, crops, musical instruments, firearms, and hunting and fishing equipment, which are primarily for personal, family or household use;
 5. Your interest in one or more items of jewelry, not to exceed \$400.00 in one item of jewelry and not to exceed \$ 200 in every other item of jewelry;
 6. Your interest, not to exceed an aggregate of \$750.00 in all implements, professional books, or tools of your profession, trade or business, including agriculture.

The actual value of any item of your personal property is measured by the price it could be sold at considering its present age and condition.
If you want to claim this property exempt, you must do the following. A hearing will be held on the _____ day of _____, 2 _____, at 11:00 A.M. in Courtroom 1-A, 301 W. Third Street, Dayton, Ohio 45402.
